

SRIXON to Hold Tennis Racket Demo Day Event in UK —Announces “Afternoon Tea and Tennis with Kevin Anderson”—

SRIXON Headquarters (Head office: Kobe, Japan; President: Kazuo Kinameri) is pleased to announce that on June 25, 2016 it will host “Saturday Afternoon Tea & Tennis with Kevin Anderson by Surbiton Racket & Fitness Club and SRIXON” at the Surbiton Racket & Fitness Club¹ in the UK. Taking part in the event will be Kevin Anderson of South Africa, who has a career high ATP world ranking of No. 10, as well as Misaki Doi and Kurumi Nara of Japan, and Zarina Diyas of Kazakhstan.²

The impetus behind the event came from local tennis fans and members of the Surbiton Racket & Fitness Club, as well as other local tennis clubs, following Kevin Anderson’s impressive runner-up performance at last year’s Aegon Championships at nearby Queen’s Club, an ATP World Tour 500 Series event. It is expected that a number of junior players will attend this event, as the club will be hosting qualifying matches for the Wimbledon Junior Championships on the same day.³

When will the event take place?

What is the schedule?

The schedule of the event is as follows:

- 2:00 Participants and attendees gather on court
- 2:10 Event begins with opening remarks by SRIXON staff and Kevin Anderson
- 3:30 Photo shoot and autograph signing
- 4:00 Event concludes with afternoon tea and other refreshments

Please note that this event is intended as an opportunity for attendees to meet Kevin Anderson. The exact program will be decided on the day of the event by Mr. Anderson and his coach, Mr. Neville Godwin. SRIXON demo rackets will be made available for attendees' use.

On what type of court will the event be held?

Two grass courts will be made available for this event.

How much does it cost?

Registration for the event is free (including refreshments) but the number of attendees is limited to 30 people.
